What?

Following the escalations of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict since October 7, 2023, there are major tensions between Jews and Arabs, Israelis and Palestinians. Meanwhile, the way the conflict is dealt with in Germany is often characterized by polarization and a lack of first-hand knowledge and understanding. Take part in a one-week seminar with Germans, Jewish Israelis, and Palestinians with Israeli citizenship. Together we will explore our personal and national identities, how they are connected, and the ways discrimination is shown in nowadays Israel and Germany. To this end, we will work with a multitude of dialogue methods, movement, artistic workshops, lectures, excursions, and more.

When and where?

August 1st to 9th, 2026, at the Stiftung wannseeFORUM youth education center in Berlin, Germany.

Participant fee is 150 €. Accommodation and food will be cared for. Travel costs will be covered.

Who can join?

Young adults in the ages of 20 to 26 (exceptions possible) who are residents of Israel and Germany.
